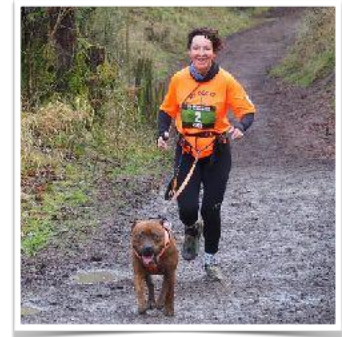

The terrain and distance however, make it a good stepping stone for people considering looking at longer distances in the future.

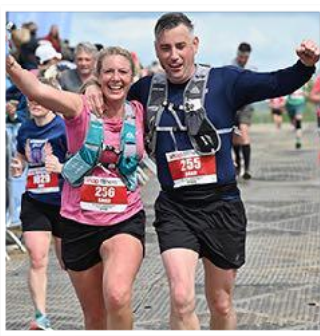
